## BCC Band Boosters November 18, 2013

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Greg Helmling. Also in attendance were Mary Beth Auch, Mary Schnettler, Ann Herek, Steve Czarnecki, Wendy Czarnecki, Kristy Keenan, Scott Stuifbergen, Wendy Verhaeghe, Tricia Wilson, Brenda Kaufman and secretary Diana Sevilla.

Steve Czarnecki moved that the minutes of the October 29, 2013, meeting be amended to reflect that the disc of band photos he is preparing as a fundraiser is a DVD not a CD, and to correct the spelling of Scott Stuifbergen's name. The motion passed and the minutes were approved as amended.

Steve said he will have some for sale at the Jazz Dinner on Nov. 19 and at the concert/cookie walk on Dec. 11. Brenda Kaufman and Tricia Wilson said cookie sales on Dec. 11 will begin at 5:30 p.m.

Brenda Kaufman moved that the Boosters purchase an ad in this year's CHS yearbook, waiting until details about the ad and coverage of the band program in the yearbook are settled before making the payment. The motion was approved.
