

BCC Band Boosters

April 29, 2014

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:19 p.m. by Greg Helmling. In attendance were Mary Schnettler, Ann Herek, Steve Czarnecki, Kristy Keenan, Scott Stuijbergen, Wendy Verhaeghe, Brenda Kaufman, Sue Sova, Jodi Welter and Secretary Diana Sevilla.

Steve Czarnecki moved that the minutes of the March 2014 meeting be approved. The motion was seconded and approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT - Kristy Keenan presented the Treasurer's report. Transfers and deposits were reported. A new method of presenting the Treasurer's Report was discussed, with each report showing all activity for the preceding calendar month. For example, May's Treasurer's Report will include all transactions made from April 1 to April 30 and so on. Mary Schnettler moved that future Treasurer's Reports use the new format. The motion was approved.

BAND DIRECTOR'S REPORT - Kristy Keenan provided details surrounding 2014 Band Bounce. Tickets are \$5 adults, \$3 students, age 5 and under free. She had handouts for the flower sale, shadow box workshops, and State Festival for Wind Symphony. The Spring Concert will be May 28.

NEW BUSINESS - Scott Stuijbergen suggested the Band Boosters pay the fee for piano accompanist Mary Herlache to play for students who make it to state-level Solo & Ensemble competition. These are students who have already competed at regional level and have been invited to States based on their scores. Students have paid for an accompanist out of their band accounts for the first round. Charges are approximately \$50 per student. Brenda Kaufman made a motion to have Band Boosters pay for States accompanist. Wendy Verhaeghe seconded. The motion was approved.

Next month we will be discussing electing officers as well as recruiting new members.

OLD BUSINESS - Band Bounce details were discussed, including the final concession plans, merchandise and ticket volunteers. Ann Herek and Wendy Verhaeghe will shop for concession items and restock as necessary.

Brenda Kaufman moved that the meeting adjourn until Tuesday, May 27, 2013. The motion was approved.
