

BCC Band Boosters - August 27, 2013

NEW BUSINESS - Steve Czarnecki discussed the idea of having a photo disk available with last year's band photos that he took over the course of the year available for a nominal fee of about \$5. Everyone in attendance agreed it would be well received.
